## **Judicial Review on Amendments to the Licensed Land Surveyors Act: Case Management Outcome**

---

Following our previous update on the judicial review against the Licensed Land Surveyors (Amendment) Act 2024, the Institution of Geospatial and Remote Sensing Malaysia (IGRSM) would like to share the latest development from the case management session held on 17 September 2025 at the High Court of Malaya.

The Court has scheduled the next case management on 17 October 2025, during which a hearing date for IGRSM's stay application is expected to be fixed. The same session will also address the Respondents' application to strike out the judicial review.

To recap, our stay application seeks to prevent the enforcement of the Licensed Land Surveyors (Amendment) Act 2024, not just for IGRSM members, but for all affected professionals across various sectors - pending the final decision of the judicial review.

The official interim stay order granted by the High Court remains in effect for IGRSM and its members. For your reference, the stay order can be accessed at: <https://shorturl.at/TrWpY>
